ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

ACCIÓN CONTRA LA POBREZA, INC.

We, the undersigned natural persons, all being of the age of eighteen years or more, acting as incorporators under the Utah Nonprofit Corporation and Cooperative Association Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

Article I: Name

The name of this corporation is Acción Contra la Pobreza, Inc.

Article II: Duration

The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.

Article III: Purpose

- (a) To act and operate exclusively as a nonprofit corporation pursuant to the laws of the State of Utah, and to act and operate as a charitable organization in enabling individuals, families, organizations, and communities to provide relief to the poor and distressed or underprivileged, and to promote social welfare through social and economic development locally and worldwide.
- (b) To engage in any and all activities and pursuits, and to support or assist such other organizations, as may be reasonably related to the foregoing and following purposes.
- (c) To engage in any and all other lawful purposes, activities and persuits, which are substantially similar to the foregoing and which are or may hereafter be authorized by Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and are consistent with those powers described in the Utah Nonprofit Corporation and Cooperation Association Act, as amended and supplemented.
- (d) To solicit and receive contributions, purchase, own and sell real and personal property, to make contracts, to invest corporate funds, to spend corporate funds for corporate purposes. and to engage in any activity in furtherance of, incidental to, or connected with any of the other purposes.
- (e) No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered to the corporation and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forthherein.

- (f) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propagands, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office except as authorized under the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended and supplemented.
- (g) The corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)2 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Article IV: Members / Stock

The corporation shall not have any class of members or stock.

Article V: By-Laws

Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation shall be set forth in the By-Laws.

Article VI: Trustees

The number of trustees of this Corporation shall be three, or more than three, as fixed from time to time by the By-Laws of the Corporation. The number of trustees constituting the present Board of Trustees of the Corporation is three, and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as trustees until their successors are elected and shall qualify are:

Article X: Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended or supplemented, or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the country in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
